Dear Student and Parent

Following the Prime Ministers address on 22 September 2020 and the new restrictions that are to be implemented in England, we are taking some further actions to mitigate the risks of COVID-19 infections. These actions are important as we continue to prioritise the health and safety of our staff and students. We are also taking these actions to minimise the impact and disruption to learning and working of others following a confirmed case.

Therefore from Monday 28 September:
