

Travelling on the college buses

At Peterborough College your safety is at the centre of all we do, travelling on the college buses is no exception.

Due to COVID19 there are some restrictions put in place for your own safety and that of the drivers. Each bus is thoroughly sanitised before and after each journey by the drivers or the bus company.

There are certain measures we ask all students to adhere to when travelling on a bus.

- Keep one metre apart whilst waiting to get onto your bus with your face mask on
- Face masks to be worn at all times covering the mouth and nose whilst travelling including getting on and off the bus.
Please bring your own face mask with you. Without a face mask you will not be allowed to travel on the bus.
If you are exempt from wearing a face mask you must be wearing a sunflower lanyard. Sunflower lanyards can be issued by the college following a risk assessment with our Wellbeing or Facilities team.
- Hand sanitiser must be used when getting onto the bus in the morning and the evening. Please bring your own sanitiser with you.
- Only one student onto the bus at a time
- Seats must be filled from the back of the bus first working forwards. The seat you have in the morning is the seat you must have in the evening.
- No eating or drinking whilst on the bus
- Take all rubbish with you when leaving the bus
- Getting off the bus will begin from the front of the bus.

Failure to comply with these measures could result in your not being allowed to travel or fines being issued by the bus company.
