Dear Student and Parent

The government has issued guidance for colleges (you can find a copy [HERE](#)) on how the new national restrictions will operate. This email sets out what this means for our students.

Key points for further education colleges

- Further education colleges will remain open during the new national lockdown, so Stamford College/Peterborough College will be largely continuing with the current mix of face-to-face teaching and online learning. Your teaching programme won't change, unless your tutor advises differently.
- Apprenticeships and other training in the workplace, such as supported internships and traineeships, will continue where employers are still operating during lockdown. Work placements will be considered on a case-by-case basis. Please contact your tutor if you have any questions about your particular situation.
- Clinically extremely vulnerable (CEV) students are advised not to attend education while the national restrictions are in place (see information below). However, students who live with someone who is CEV, but who are not CEV themselves, should still attend college. The link to the government's guidance is [HERE](#).
- Sport and physical education can continue as part of education and training, with outdoor sports prioritised and indoor sports using large indoor spaces where possible. However, competitions between different colleges won't be taking place.

Clinically Extremely Vulnerable (CEV) Students

- Students who are CEV (i.e. those with a letter from the NHS or their GP confirming this) are advised to study from home and not to come into college.
